A PERSONALISED SERVICE

BLOCKS OF OUTREACH

If you believe your school would benefit from multiple outreach sessions, we offer "blocks" of outreach (3-6 visits) over the course of a half-term to address your needs and concerns. These weekly visits include an observation and recommendations report, learning environment support, regular debriefs with your school SENCO/Inclusion Manager, teacher drop-ins, and follow-up strategy sessions with classroom staff. This can also include transition support of students with LAN from primary to secondary school.

SINGLE VISIT OBSERVATION WITH REPORT

We can provide a full observation report and list of recommendations for a student or groups of students.

This includes follow-up conversations with relevant school staff, parents and carers.
