

What you need: Paper & pens red, yellow, blue and black

## What to do:

- 1. Look at the work of Mondrian, Calder & Miro.
- 2. Using a black pen or pencil and a ruler, draw a rectangle as large as you can on a piece of paper. (Top tip: you could draw round something which is rectangular instead.)
- 3. Write your initials in capital letters touching the top and bottom of the rectangle.
- 4. Draw 2 lines from top to bottom of the rectangle at any angle you like.
- 5. Draw 2 lines sideways across the rectangle at any angle you like.
- 6. Using just 3 primary colours (Red, Blue and Yellow) and black, **Carefully** colour in some of the closed shapes different colours.
- 7. Try not to have any of the same colours next to each other. You can leave some parts white.

## What it is good for:

Transferring of skills

Manual dexterity hand eye coordination.


Maths: closed and open shapes
