Purpose of Post

Gosden House values the creative arts as a route for young people to:

- Engage meaningfully with learning.
- Maintain and develop emotional wellbeing and good mental health.
- Access curricular and non-curricular learning.
- Express themselves and communicate with others.

The Drama teacher will work collaboratively with classroom teachers and the Arts team to deliver curriculum learning through Drama. In addition the Drama teacher will work collaboratively with Gosden staff and external providers to offer Gosden pupils a wider enrichment and vocational offer through Drama and the Performing Arts.

Key activities and Responsibilities

- Plan and teach Drama to Primary and Secondary pupils, modifying the National Curriculum to meet the needs of learners with Moderate Learning Difficulties (MLD).
- Collaborate with teachers to co-plan and deliver Drama activities within the curriculum.
- Deliver Arts Award and support other vocational subjects, including Functional Skills, at Key Stage 4, up to Entry Level 3.
- Liaise with external organisations to access theatre and performing arts activities onsite and elsewhere.
- Contribute to the maintenance of Gosden House's Gold Artsmark award.
- Organise and lead enrichment opportunities across the school.
- Collaborate with creative artists and staff within the school to organize and deliver events and creative opportunities.
