We are looking to recruit an Outdoor Learning Lead, to provide high-quality outdoor learning opportunities for pupils at Gosden House School, a specialist setting for pupils with Moderate Learning Difficulties. The Outdoor Learning Lead will have responsibility for the effective use and development of the school's outdoor learning environments, including the Outdoor Learning site, courtyard classroom, and wider school grounds.

The role involves working collaboratively across the school to plan and deliver a structured and inclusive programme of outdoor learning activities for pupils from Reception through to Year 11, ensuring activities are accessible, purposeful, and aligned with pupils' individual learning needs.

We require a good general education, a minimum of 5 GCSEs or equivalent preferred. GCSE or equivalent level 2 grade in English and Maths.

Salary is graded at PS6, according to experience (Surrey Pay Scale).
